Undergraduate:

Modules on Direct Restorative Dentistry, Direct Restorative Materials, Endodontics and Paediatric Dentistry for the degree **Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS)** (Duration 2nd, 3rd and 4th year) The second year is Preclinical Direct Restorative procedures. The final examination is in the October/November examination period of the 4th year. Admission to the 2nd year depends on completion of the 1st year successfully including Dental Assisting that is offered by the Department of Operative Dentistry

Modules on Direct Restorative Dentistry, Direct Restorative Materials and Paediatric Dentistry for the degree **Bachelor of Dental Therapy (B Dent Ther)**(Duration only in the 3rd year) The first 6 weeks of the 3rd year is Preclinical Direct Restorative procedures. The final examination is in the October/November examination period of the 3th year. Admission depends on completion of the 2nd year successfully including Dental Assisting and Expanded Functions that was offered by the Department of Operative Dentistry in the 1st and 2nd year of study.

Modules on Dental Assisting and Direct Restorative Materials for the degree **Bachelor of Oral Hygiene (BOH)**(Dental Assisting in the 1st year of study and Direct Restorative Materials in the 2nd year of study)

Post Graduate Diploma in Dentistry (Endodontics and Paedodontics)

Admission requirements and student selection is based on: Registered as a Dental Surgeon or equivalent in the country in which the qualification was obtained. The course is followed part time and over a period of two years but can be completed in less time if suitable arrangements can be made. The aim of the PG Dip Dent is to provide Dentists an opportunity to improve their knowledge base in Endodontics and Paedodontics.

The duration is a minimum of 1 year full time and 2 years part time with a maximum of 2 years full time and 3 years part time.
